## MINISTRY OF THE ECOLOGICAL TRANSITION, RESPONSIBLE FOR GREEN TECHNOLOGIES AND NEGOTIATIONS REGARDING THE CLIMATE

Decree of 17 July 2009 granting the lease of liquid or gaseous hydrocarbon mines known as the "Nonville Lease" (Seine-et-Marne) to simplified joint-stock company Bridgeoil

NOR: DEVE0908581D

By Decree dated the 17th July 2009, the liquid or gaseous hydrocarbon mines located within the perimeter defined below, which partly extend into the districts of Nonville, La Genevraye, Villemer and Darvault, are leased to the simplified joint-stock company Bridgeoil, headquartered at 1, Boulevard Vivier-Merle, immeuble Tour Suisse, 69003 Lyon (France).

In conformity with the map extract (1:25,000 scale) appended to this decree (1), the perimeter of the area covered by this lease, called the "Nonville Lease", is delimited by the meridian arcs and parallels joining the vertices whose geographical coordinates are specified below, the meridian of origin being the Paris meridian:

This perimeter surrounds a surface area of approx. 10 square kilometers.

The lease is granted for a period of twenty-five years, starting from the publication date of this decree in the *Journal Officiel* of the French Republic.

The subsoil royalty amount owed by the leaseholder to the owners of the surface land, by application of article 37 of the French mining code, is set at 15 Euros per hectare of land included within the lease perimeter.
